The Royal Dames of Cancer Research was founded in April, 1969, when the Cancer Research Laboratory, first known as the Genetic Life Center, moved to Fort Lauderdale. Each member was dedicated to the endowment of cancer research.

In May of 1972, because of a contribution by Leo Goodwin, Jr., the cancer research laboratory was renamed the Goodwin Institute for Cancer Research, in memory of the senior Mr. Goodwin.

In 2000, the name of the Institute was changed to Rumbaugh-Goodwin Institute for Cancer Research (RGI) to reflect a generous gift from Joseph (Joe) Rumbaugh.

In 2005, the Institute became part of Nova Southeastern University.

The Royal Dames of Cancer Research has raised millions of dollars to support the research and educational programs at RGI. Funds have financed laboratory equipment, library books, journals and vital research materials.

Being part of the great fight against cancer is a mission the Royal Dames are devoted to. We will keep going, passing the torch, until the time comes when the cure is found.



Message from the President



Dear Royal Dames, Honored Sponsors and Guests:

This certainly has been a year and a half of crises and challenges. If there is one thing that has been impressed on our collective consciousness, it is that scientific research is the best and probably the only defense we have to preserve mankind. We stood by and could only watch helplessly, as an invader we could not even see mercilessly killed millions of people. If research had not been at the ready, a vaccine (usually takes 5 to 10 years to create one) could not have been developed in under a year.

In an era where instant information and gratification is demanded, cancer research seems an appallingly slow and painstaking process. Many people became discouraged, questioning what had we accomplished. It is understandable, but not realistic. This year that research is yielding results. The Rumbaugh-Goodwin Institute (RGI), under the leadership of Dr. Appu Rathinavelu has developed diagnostic testing for the early detection of Chemotherapy Induced Peripheral Neuropathy (CIPN). This can be a lifesaver as many patients in the past have died from this side effect of chemotherapy. On another front, a pharmaceutical company has shown interest in licensing our F-16 compound which will lead to clinical trials being done. RGI has credited the Dames for helping support these advances.


Congratulations
